

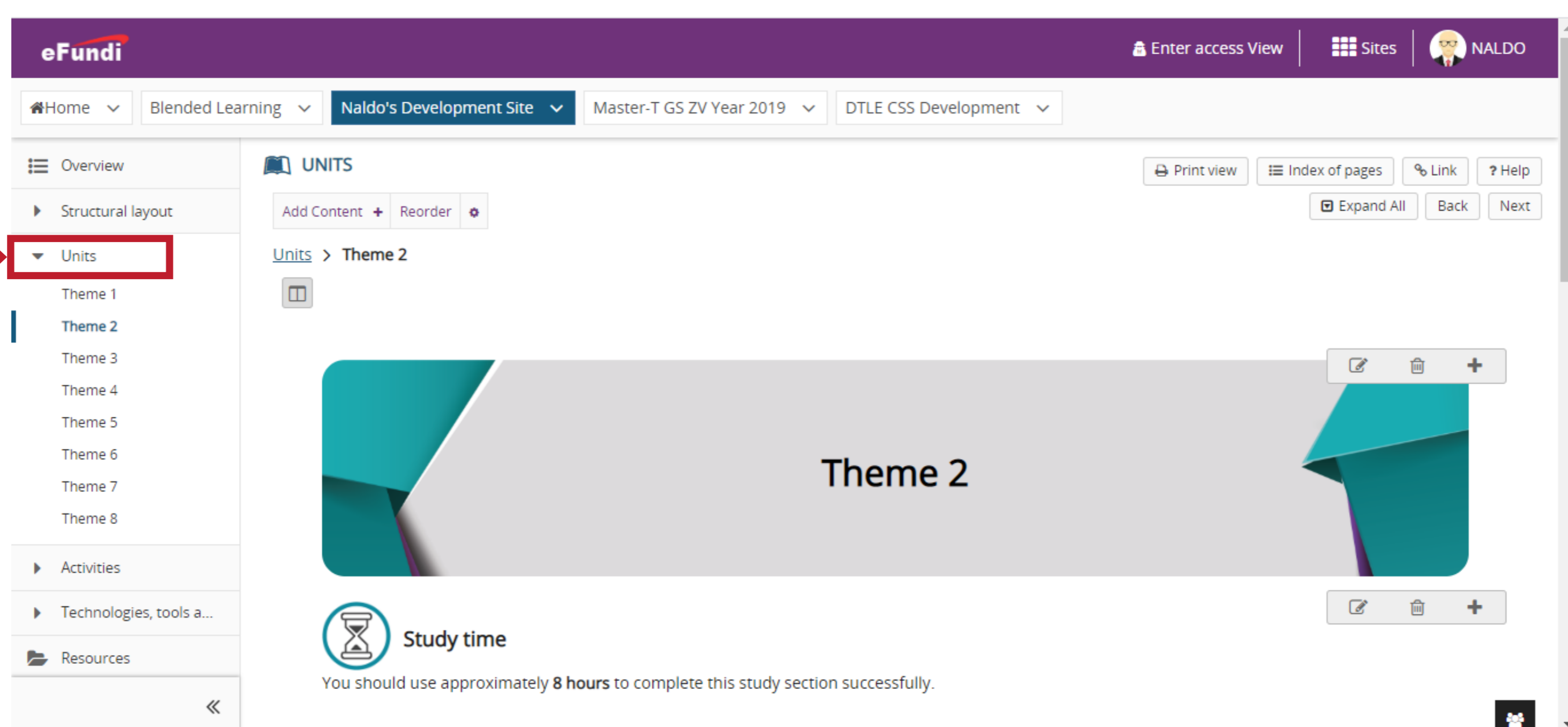

## Exporting Lessons for offline use

If you are planning your module around the fact that you want students to download the content for offline use, consider your student's journey through each section. Careful planning and organisation is essential. If you are using HTML or Bootstrap elements to create striking visual effects, test it first by downloading it yourself in order to see how it will display.

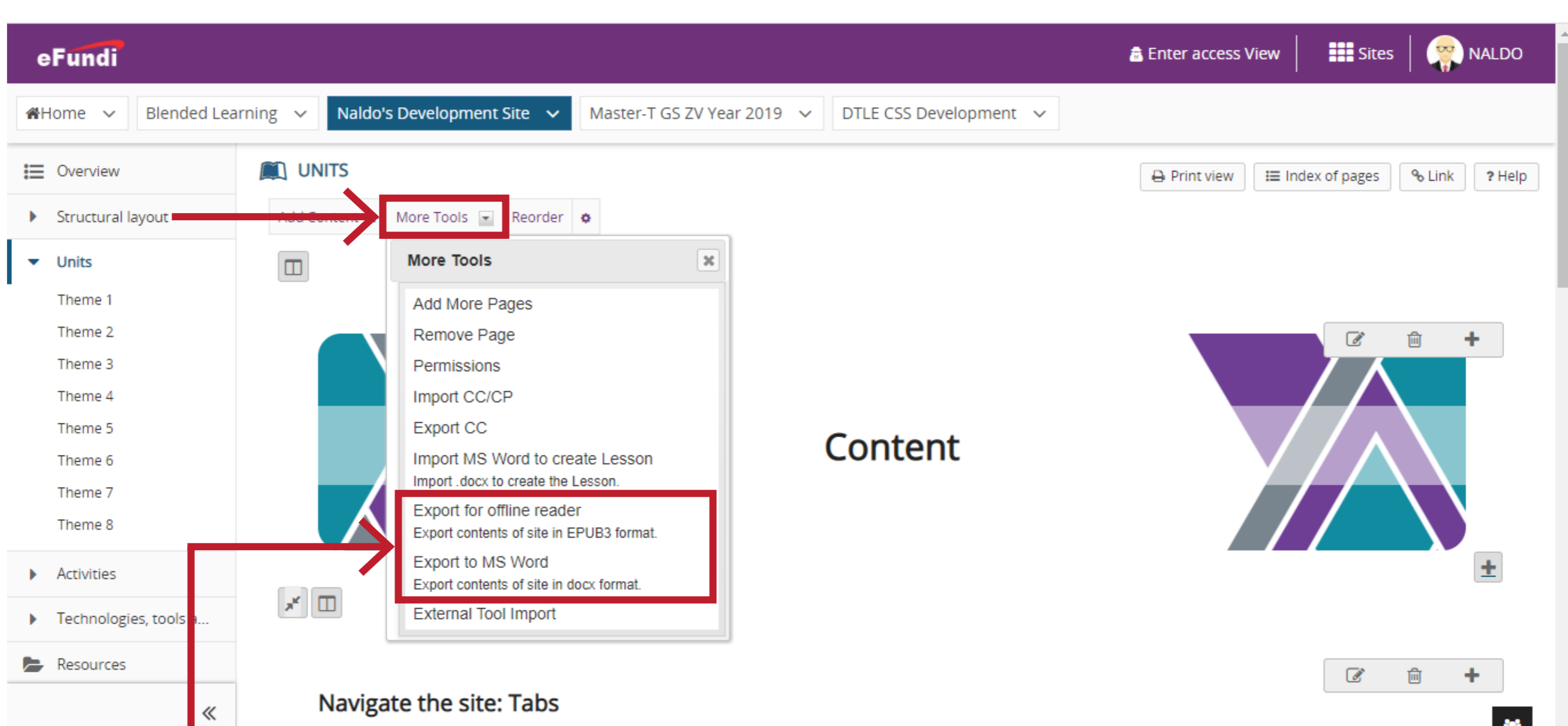
Follow the steps below to export your Lessons page

**1** In your eFundi site, navigate toward the Lessons item you want to export. In the example below it is "Units".



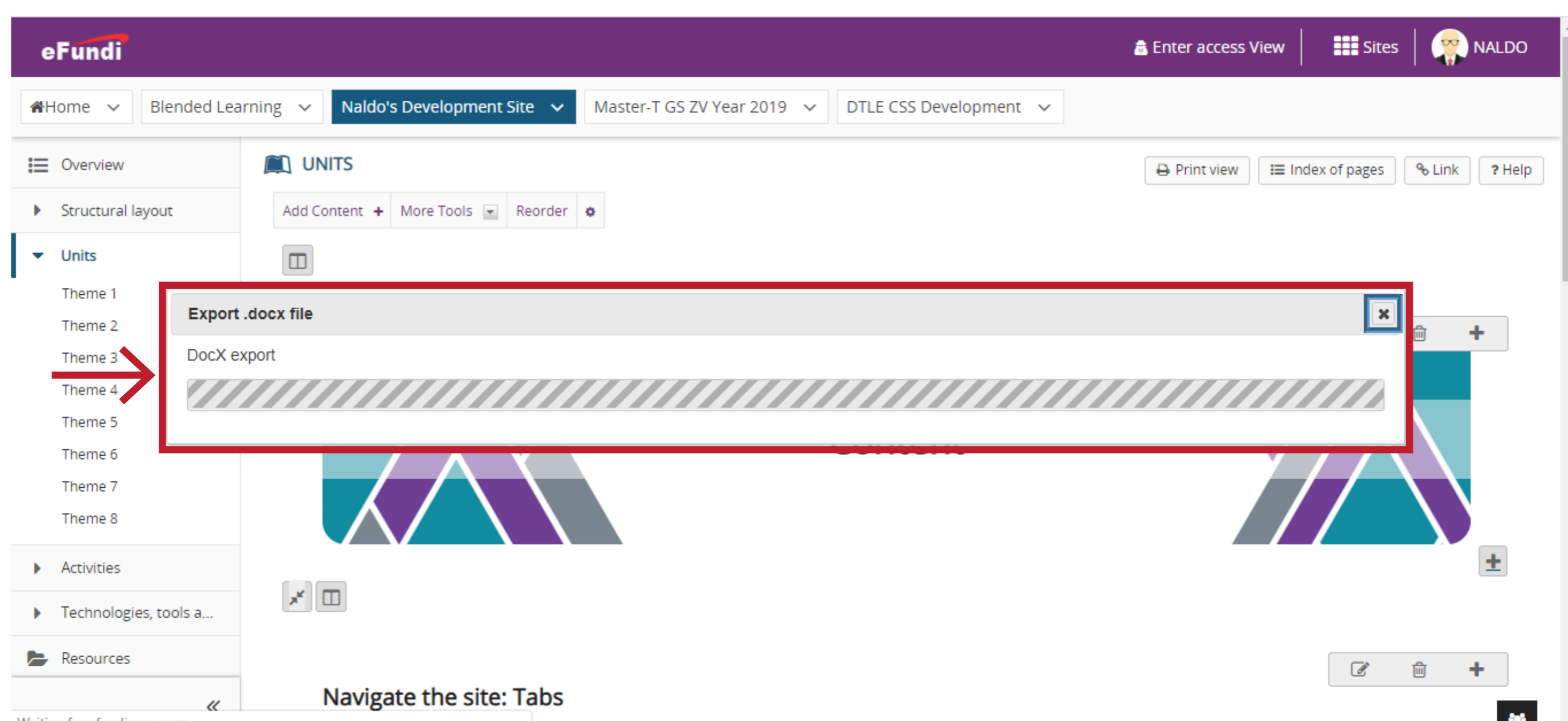
All the content underneath "Units" will therefore be exported. Sub-sections, such as an individual theme, cannot be exported on its own.

**2** Click on the menu item called "More Tools" found at the top of the screen to open a list of options.



Note: to view the EPUB3 format special tools may need to be installed to view the exported content.

**3** Select the appropriate format in which you want to download your content.



A notification will appear about the status of the export.  
**Note:** DOCX formats (Microsoft Word) may need to be formatted for better legibility.
