# eFundi Tutorial: Test & Quizzes How do I allow a student to retake a test or quiz



If a student has completed all of their available submissions to an assessment, you can allow them to retake it.

# Step 1: Go to Tests & Quizzes

Select the **Tests & Quizzes** tool from the Tool Menu of your course site.



# Step 2: Select the Published Copies tab

You'll be presented with the list of students. Underneath the name of the student who needs to retake the test or quiz, click **Allow retake?** 

#### Notes:

- An assessment must be **Active** (i.e. the **due** or **late acceptance** date must be in the future), for a student to be able to access it. For instructions to edit assessment dates, see <u>What are the Availability and Submissions options for an assessment?</u>
- If the assessment allows multiple submissions, and the student has an incomplete submission with time available on it, the student can complete

their available submission. The instructor will not have the option to **Allow retake** for that student.

- Allowing a retake gives the student a new, blank copy of the assessment to take.
- It is sometimes required that the lecturer first delete the student's first attempt before they will be able to complete the retake opportunity.

### Step 6: Click Retake to confirm

You'll be asked if you're sure you want to allow the selected student to retake the quiz. Click **Retake** to confirm.
