# eFundi Tutorial: Test & Quizzes How do I copy questions from the question pool into an assessment



This allows for individual questions from a particular Question Pool to be copied and added to a new or existing assessment.

**Note:** Questions copied from a pool are presented in the order listed in the assessment. To deliver questions randomly from a pool, see <u>How do I set up a</u> random question set?

### Step 1: Go to Tests & Quizzes

Select the Tests & Quizzes tool from the Tool Menu of your course site.



### Step 2: Select an assessment

Questions may be added to any assessment. Select an existing assessment or create a new one.
