Answer Garden



Description & Purpose: AnswerGarden is an easy-to-use online tool that can be used to elicit single word/concept answers from students anonymously. A word cloud is generated from all the answers. Predominant answers display larger.

Access: <u>https://answergarden.ch/</u> No login required to create a topic/question. Click on "Create AnswerGarden" or click on the + sign. Add a question or topic to the "Topic" space.

Features: Control answer length (20/40 characters). Enable the Spam Filter to detect and remove common unwanted answers. Select one of the following modes:

Brainstorm Mode: Respondents can submit an unlimited number of answers, including unlimited copies of the same answer.

Classroom Mode: Respondents can submit an unlimited number of answers, but may only submit each answer once.

Moderator Mode: Each answer will be submitted to the AntiGarden, so you can manually approve these entries to your AnswerGarden. *Locked Mode:* The AnswerGarden is closed and no new answers can be submitted.
