What is MS Teams?

Microsoft Teams is a collaboration and messaging tool provided with your North-West University Office 365 service. This document will outline the basics of getting the Teams client installed on your computer or mobile device, and will get you acquainted with the basics of how to use Teams.

Installing Teams

PC/Mac: Navigate to the following website and click the link appropriate for your operating system: <u>https://teams.microsoft.com/downloads</u>

After the download, right click the installer file and select "run as administrator".

iOS: Download the Teams app from the App Store: https://aka.ms/iosteams

Android: Download the Teams app from the Play Store: <u>https://aka.ms/androidteams</u>



Sign in and get started

To login to Teams sign-in with the following username:

NWUstudent#@student365.msfed.nwu.ac.za (e.g. 12345678@student365.msfed.nwu.ac.za – where NWUstudent# is your University Number)



A new window will appear. Choose "Mobile login"

Sign in with the email already entered, and the same password that you use to sign into eFundi.
