

How does a student join a group on an eFundi course site

This tutorial is explanatory of the steps you need to take when joining a group on your eFundi course sites.

Not all sites have groups to join as it is dependent on your lecturer if they will set up groups for a particular teaching and learning purpose.

Joining a group on an existing eFundi course site

1. Go to your module code and click on Site Info
